What is a Nest Thermostat?

Nest thermostats are smart thermostats. The Nest thermostat learns about your home: how quickly it heats, what temperatures you like, when you like it warm or cool, the outside temperature, and even the weather forecast. It uses advanced algorithms to calculate how to give you the best balance of comfort and reduced energy use. The Nest thermostat saves an average of 10 percent on heating bills. What other features does the Nest have?

When you choose an energy saving temperature, the Nest Leaf will appear. Use the Nest Leaf to help guide you to personalized energy savings for your home. The Leaf will challenge you to choose temperatures that are a little lower than you're used to. Simply setting the thermostat to save one degree can save you an additional five percent on your heating bill.

With the Auto-Away feature the Nest turns itself down when you are not home, so you avoid heating an empty house. If you connect your thermostat to your smart phone, it will sense when you are coming and going from your home and adjust the temperature. You can also get alerts if something goes wrong with your furnace and if you need to change your furnace air filters, another big energy saver.

Can I find out how much energy I have saved?

Nest tracks your heating usage and provides a monthly report so you can see when your home used the most energy for heat. The more you know, the more you can save!

How do I take advantage of this program?

To participate, you'll need a central electric heating system like an electric furnace or heat pump.

You'll receive a Nest thermostat free of charge (a \$250 value) if you commit to installing it in your home for two years. Participation will be on a first come, first serve basis.

How do I install my Nest thermostat?
